Environmental Considerations

A. Introduction

Federal Regulation

According to requirements of SAFETEA-LU, a long-range transportation plan shall include a discussion of types of potential environmental consideration activities and potential steps to carry out these activities, including activities that may have the greatest potential to restore and maintain the environmental functions affected by the plan. This requirement shall be met through the development of a discussion with Federal, State, and tribal wildlife, land management, and regulatory agencies.

The Act stipulates that metropolitan planning organizations shall consult, as appropriate, with State and local agencies responsible for land use management, natural resources, environmental protection, conservation, and historic preservation concerning the development of a long-range transportation plan. The consultation shall involve the following, as appropriate:

1. Comparison of transportation plans with State conservation plans or maps, if available; or
2. Comparison of transportation plans to inventories of natural or historic resources, if available.

Goal and Objectives

The goal of this effort is *to make the consideration of environmental issues an integral part of the MPO's transportation planning process*. The objectives of this effort are:

- To identify any potential conflict between the implementation of projects recommended in the Transportation Plan and the area's sensitive environmental features.
- To develop an inventory of all sensitive environmental issues related to the implementation of projects recommended in the Transportation Plan.
- To begin the consideration of environmental issues prior to the implementation phase and during the planning process.
- To provide an environmental reference and resource document for the implementation of projects in the Transportation Plan.

Status

Benton County has a wealth of environmental studies and inventories of its flora and fauna, in large part due to research produced by Oregon State University (OSU), located in Corvallis. Additionally, local jurisdictions place great value on protection of our natural and built environments in implementing community projects. Notable work of local governments on the environmental issues includes:

- Beginning in 2002, Benton County and the City of Corvallis completed a collaborative five-year Natural Features Project in order to inventory and assess natural hazards and resources within the Corvallis Urban Growth Boundary and to develop a program to minimize hazards, protect resources, and ensure efficient development of the city and urban fringe. Stakeholders and property owners were involved throughout the process and approximately one hundred public meetings were conducted. The result was two programs – one for City jurisdiction, one for County jurisdiction – that work in a coordinated fashion to protect steep slope and landslide hazard areas, floodplains, riparian areas and wetlands, and areas of rare habitat and significant vegetation, while at the same time preserving property rights.
- The County program includes policies (contained in the Corvallis Urban Fringe Policies and adopted in 2005), land use regulations (contained in the Development Code), and incentives (also in the Development Code). The City of Corvallis adopted a document referred to as Land Development Code Update, Phase III in December, 2004. This document was incorporated into the City's Land Development Code.
- Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments (CWCOG) and partner cities in Linn and Benton Counties have been working with the State of Oregon to clarify regional demand for industrial land and how to address potential wetlands on those lands. The team is now pursuing a Regional General Permit and mitigation banking strategies.
- In 2005, the City of Corvallis updated its Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Manual. It requires an Erosion Prevention and Sediment Control Permit for any groundbreaking affecting at least 2,000 square feet of land.
- Adair Village worked collaboratively with eight rural communities in the southern Willamette Valley to inventory wetlands and address potential impacts of future growth on natural resources. Completion of this effort is anticipated in 2012.
- The City of Philomath, along with all CAMPO-area jurisdictions, has incorporated policies addressing natural resources and hazards in its Comprehensive Plan.
- The City of Corvallis and Benton County have established procedures for the protection of the natural environment and mitigation of the impact of their transportation projects.
- The OSU Campus and particularly its College of Forestry is renowned as a scientific institution that takes pride in the protection of the natural environment.
- Benton County adopted an erosion and sediment control ordinance as part of the National Pollution Discharge and Elimination System (NPDES) Phase II program. In order to comply with the terms of NPDES permit issued to Benton County by DEQ, the County is required to implement a permit program for erosion and sediment control from large construction sites and implement requirements for long-term, post-construction management of stormwater from developed sites. The County worked closely with the cities of Corvallis and Philomath to develop this ordinance, which went into effect in July 2011.

B. Identification of Areas of Conflict

As part of this report, CAMPO has identified areas of potential conflict between the recommendations of the Transportation Plan and the valued and/or protected environmental and historic features of the Planning Area. Using Geographic Information System (GIS) mapping software, the sensitive features within the Planning Area were overlaid with the projects recommended in the Corvallis Area Metropolitan Transportation Plan. The following maps demonstrate the areas of potential conflict. In preparing these maps the MPO consulted local, state and federal agencies.

Additionally, the Environmental Consideration section includes demonstration of compliance with requirements of Environmental Justice, Consultation with Resource Agencies and Consultation with Indian Tribes.

C. Soil

Soil types react differently under distress based upon a number of factors, including water solubility and grades of coarseness. For example, plastic soils such as clay and silt may be more susceptible to landslide than those that are not. Transportation projects occurring on these soils

may require additional attention to mitigating potential hazards brought on by the composition of soils prone to natural disaster.

Soil erosion can be broken down into three types:

1. Mass movement erosion (soil loss and movement due to the effects of gravity, including; landslips, slumps and slides)
2. Water erosion
3. Wind erosion.

The soil map is based on the 2005 Benton County Soil Survey. It demonstrates soils that are dominant within the Planning Area. Hydric soils, comprised of different types of clay and loam, are prominently mapped.

D. Waters - 303d and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL)

Every two years, DEQ is required to assess the quality of Oregon's water and report to the EPA on the condition of Oregon's waters. In doing so, DEQ prepares an Integrated Report that meets the requirements of the federal Clean Water Act (CWA) for Section 305(b) (requiring a report on the overall condition of Oregon's waters) and Section 303(d) (requiring identification of waters that do not meet water quality standards need a Total Maximum Daily Load). Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) are implemented to limit the amount of a particular pollutant that can be discharged into a body of water and still maintain water quality standards.

The most recent Integrated Report was completed in 2010, updating the previous 2004/2006 report. The Report includes an assessment of each water body where credible data are available as well as all waters identified under Section 303(d) as water quality limited and requiring a TMDL. The 2010 report includes new 303(d) listings and de-listings, and was submitted to the EPA for review in May 2011. The listings and de-listings were approved by the EPA on March 15, 2012; however the EPA proposed adding other waters to Oregon's 303(d) list and will complete additional public involvement to finalize the updates to Oregon's 2010 303(d) list. Although the report was not finalized at the time this report was completed, the approved listings/de-listings immediately became part of Oregon's 303(d) list upon approval and can be used for Clean Water Act purposes.

Water bodies which did not meet water quality standards are Water Quality Limited and are assigned Category 4 or Category 5. Water bodies in Category 5 require a pollutant Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs) thus comprise the Section 303(d) list. The affected waterways in the CAMPO are listed below, and detailed in Table 1.

According to Chapter 340-042-0025 of the Oregon Administrative Rules:

(1) The public policy of the State of Oregon is to protect, maintain and improve the quality of waters of the state for beneficial uses and to provide for prevention, abatement and control of water pollution. To achieve and maintain water quality standards, the Environmental Quality Commission may impose limitations and controls including Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs), wasteload allocations for point sources and load allocations for nonpoint sources.

E. Brownfields, Hazardous Waste Sites and Toxic Release Inventory Facilities

Brownfields and Hazardous Waste Sites

A Brownfield is a site that has been contaminated by pollution, hazardous chemicals, and/or waste. A Brownfield can be property which is abandoned, idled, or under-used commercially.

According to the Oregon DEQ Environmental Cleanup Site Information (ECSI) database, the CAMPO Planning area contains 6 brownfield sites which are on the Confirmed Release List (CRL) or in the Inventory of Hazardous Substance Sites (Inventory). An additional 28 sites are considered suspect and require further investigation. 14 previously listed sites are now listed and remediated and needing no further action.

Maintained by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), these lists provide information on sites with known or suspected releases of hazardous substances.

Sites on the Confirmed Release List must have had a release of a hazardous substance that is confirmed by meeting both of the following criteria:

- The release has been documented by qualified observation, owner/operator admission or laboratory data; and
- The release is not excluded from listing by virtue of being insignificant in quantity or hazard, regulated by another program, having been adequately cleaned up or otherwise requiring no further action.

Once listed on the CRL, a site is typically subject to a site assessment, including an in-depth review of a site’s operating history and potential extent of contamination, and describes ways in which site contamination could affect human health and the environment.

The Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 465.006 states that:

“ it is the policy of the State of Oregon to encourage reduction in the use of toxic substances and to reduce the generation of hazardous waste whenever technically and economically practicable, without shifting risks from one part of a process, environmental media or product to another. Priority shall be given to methods that reduce the amount of toxics used and, where that is not technically and economically practicable, methods that reduce the generation of hazardous waste.”

Toxic Release Inventory Facilities

Five entities within or adjacent to the CAMPO area disposed of toxic chemicals on or off site in 2010, according to the EPA Toxic Release Inventory (TRI). These sites are Evanite Fiber Corp., Green and White, Hewlett Packard Co., Oregon Rubber Mills Co., and the U.S. Army National Guard.

Identification of permitted toxic release facilities is required under the Environmental Protection Agency Act as well as Oregon’s Statewide Planning Goals and Guidelines, Goal 6, OAR 660-015-0000(6) which states:

“All waste and process discharges from future development, when combined with such discharges from existing developments shall not threaten to violate, or violate applicable state or federal environmental quality statutes, rules and standards. With respect to the air, water and land resources of the applicable air sheds and river basins described or included in state environmental quality statutes, rules, standards and implementation plans, such discharges shall not (1) exceed the carrying capacity of such resources, considering long range needs; (2) degrade such resources; or (3) threaten the availability of such resources.”

F. Critical, Threatened, Endangered, and Sensitive Fish and Wildlife Habitats

Critical Fish and Wildlife Habitats are those habitats identified by the United States Department of Fish and Wildlife and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. Staff consulted with local ODFW staff to list and map the sensitive, threatened, endangered, and critical habitat species within the Planning area.

The Oregon Administrative Rules, Chapter 635-415-0000 states that:

It is the fish and wildlife habitat mitigation policy of the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to require or recommend, depending upon the habitat protection and mitigation opportunities provided by specific statutes, mitigation for losses of fish and wildlife habitat resulting from development actions. Priority for mitigation actions shall be given to habitat for native fish and wildlife species. Mitigation actions for nonnative fish and wildlife species may not adversely affect habitat for native fish and wildlife.

Species such as the Kincaid’s Lupine and Fender’s Blue Butterfly are found in specific sensitive habitat areas identified as wet prairies. Species such as the Spotted Owl are found specifically in forest areas containing old growth forest (stands that are 50+ years old). Aquatic, riparian, grasslands, oak savannah, oak woodlands, wetlands, and wet prairies are critical habitats for the following species which may occur in the CAMPO planning area:

- Northern Red-Legged Frog

- Western Pond Turtle
- Common Kingsnake
- Waterfowl (e.g. Dusky Canada Goose)
- Shorebirds (e.g. Upland sandpiper)
- Common Nighthawk
- Streaked Horned Lark

- Western Bluebird
- Western Meadowlark
- Townsend's Big Eared Bat

G. Fish Passage Barriers

Fish Passage Barriers can be man-made or natural blockages to the free movement of fish species through a waterway. Upstream blockages that prevent spawning of fish, especially those that are identified as threatened or endangered, are of significant importance. Fish barriers can come in the form of culvert blockages, dams, shallow water, or a combination of factors that prevent fish from reaching their spawning grounds. Transportation projects that may develop new barriers, or intersect existing barriers will require adequate fish passage as directed by State law.

Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 509.585 states:

(1) It is the policy of the State of Oregon to provide for upstream and downstream passage for native migratory fish and the Legislative Assembly finds that cooperation and collaboration between public and private entities is necessary to accomplish the policy goal of providing passage for native migratory fish and to achieve the enhancement and restoration of Oregon's native salmonid populations, as envisioned by the Oregon Plan. Therefore, except as provided in ORS chapter 509, fish passage is required in all waters of this state in which native migratory fish are currently or have historically been present.

and,

(3) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife shall complete and maintain a statewide inventory of artificial obstructions in order to prioritize enforcement actions based on the needs of native migratory fish. This prioritization shall include, but need not be limited to, the degree of impact of the artificial obstruction on the native migratory fish, the biological status of the native migratory fish stocks in question and any other factor established by the department by rule...

H. Flood Plains

A flood plain is an area designated either by the State or Federal Government as being susceptible to flooding (the inundation of water in an otherwise dry area). Flood plains are usually flat areas near a prominent water feature such as a river, creek, or lake. Typically properties within a flood plain incur certain land use restrictions and higher insurance rates. Thus, identifying a flood plain is critical in land use designation and development.

The identification of flood plains is required under ORS Chapters 196.615, 196.668, 196.815, and 197.230; as well as Oregon's Statewide Planning Goals and Guidelines Goal 7: Areas Subject to Natural Hazards in order to prevent and/or mitigate the potential negative impact on human life, wildlife, and vegetation.

I. Forest Lands and Zones

Identification of forest lands within the planning area is important for the purposes of mitigating the impact that transportation projects have on the forest environment. Forests play an important role in the ecological diversity of a region. According to Oregon's Statewide Planning Goal 4: Forest Lands OAR 660-015-0000(4) the purpose is to:

Conserve forest lands by maintaining the forest land base and to protect the state's forest economy by making possible economically efficient forest practices that assure the continuous growing and harvesting of forest tree species as the leading use on forest land consistent with sound management of soil, air, water, and fish and wildlife resources and to provide for recreational opportunities and agriculture.

Oregon State University manages the majority of forest land adjacent to the Planning Area as part of the McDonald-Dunn Forest. The 2005 McDonald-Dunn Forest Plan outlines a management strategy for these 11,250 acres of forest land. The Plan guides management practices according to four different landscape-scale themes. Within each landscape-scale theme, special areas are identified and special issues are addressed, under the direction of faculty from the Department of Forestry. The four themes include:

Theme #1: Short Rotation Wood Production with High Return on Investment.

Establishes and manages Douglas-fir plantations to become financially competitive with intensively managed plantations of pine and other species in the southeastern United States and elsewhere, maximizing yields of wood products valuable for domestic mills.

Theme #2: High-quality, Growth maximizing Timber Production.

Emphasizes long rotations of even-aged Douglas-fir dominated plantations, established, managed, and harvested on rotation cycles that optimize yield of high-quality wood, generally one to several decades longer than for Theme 1.

Theme #3: Visually Sensitive, Even-aged Forest.

Seeks to create even-aged forests of primarily Douglas-fir using a two-storied, shelterwood system to maintain continuous tree cover with options for long-term retention of some shelter trees for non-wood forest values.

Theme #4: Structurally Diverse Complex Forest.

Multi-aged, mixed-species forests of primarily Douglas-fir are established and managed using group-selection harvests, while maintaining structural diversity and associated habitats within stands.

Areas encompassed by the McDonald-Dunn Forest are illustrated in Map 11: CAMPO Area Natural Areas and Open Space and Map 13: CAMPO Area Parks, Trails and Open Space.

J. Historic Sites, Buildings, and Districts

There are several state and federal laws and regulations that call for preservation and/or enhancement of cultural resources. Of specific relevance to transportation projects are Section

106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA) of 1966 and 23 CFR 774 (formerly Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966).

NHPA Section 106 states:

The head of any Federal agency having direct or indirect jurisdiction over a proposed Federal or federally assisted undertaking in any State and the head of any Federal department or independent agency having authority to license any undertaking shall, prior to the approval of the expenditure of any Federal funds on the undertaking or prior to the issuance of any license, as the case may be, take into account the effect of the undertaking on any district, site, building, structure, or object that is included in or eligible for inclusion in the National Register. The head of any such Federal agency shall afford the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation established under Title II of this Act a reasonable opportunity to comment with regard to such undertaking.

23 CFR 774 (formerly Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act) states:

The Administration may not approve the use, as defined in § 774.17, of Section 4(f) property unless a determination is made under paragraph (a) or (b) of this section.

(a) The Administration determines that:

(1) There is no feasible and prudent avoidance alternative, as defined in § 774.17, to the use of land from the property; and

(2) The action includes all possible planning, as defined in § 774.17, to minimize harm to the property resulting from such use; or

(b) The Administration determines that the use of the property, including any measure(s) to minimize harm (such as any avoidance, minimization, mitigation, or enhancement measures) committed to by the applicant, will have a de minimis impact, as defined in § 774.17, on the property.

Historic properties are any historic district, site, building, structure or object included in, or eligible for inclusion in, the National Register of Historic Places. The following table identifies key historic sites, buildings, and districts within the CAMPO Planning Area which are listed in the National Register of Historic Places. A complete listing of all historic properties, including those which are eligible but not listed in the National Register, is included as Attachment 1.

K. Natural Features and Greenbelts

Benton County and the City of Corvallis collaboratively implemented a five-year Natural Features Project in order to inventory and assess natural hazards and resources within the Corvallis Urban Growth Boundary and to develop a program to minimize hazards, protect resources, and ensure efficient development of the city and urban fringe. As part of this work,

inventories were completed of streams, wetlands, riparian areas, flood plains, areas prone to landslides and wildfires, steep slopes, wildlife habitats, tree groves, scenic views, and archeological resources.

The result was two programs – one for City jurisdiction, one for County jurisdiction – that work in a coordinated fashion to protect steep slope and landslide hazard areas, floodplains, riparian areas and wetlands, and areas of rare habitat and significant vegetation, while at the same time preserving property rights. The County program includes policies (contained in the Corvallis Urban Fringe Policies and adopted in 2005), land use regulations (contained in the Development Code), and incentives (also in the Development Code). The City of Corvallis adopted a document referred to as Land Development Code Update, Phase III in December, 2004. This document was incorporated into the City’s Land Development Code.

This work was completed in part to meet Oregon’s Statewide Planning Goals & Guidelines Goal 5: Natural Resources, Scenic and Historic Areas, and Open Spaces; OAR 660-015-0000(5) which states that:

“Local governments shall adopt programs that will protect natural resources and conserve scenic, historic, and open space resources for present and future generations. These resources promote a healthy environment and natural landscape that contributes to Oregon's livability. The following resources shall be inventoried:

- a. Riparian corridors, including water and riparian areas and fish habitat;*
- b. Wetlands;*
- c. Wildlife Habitat;*
- d. Federal Wild and Scenic Rivers;*
- e. State Scenic Waterways;*
- f. Groundwater Resources;*
- g. Approved Oregon Recreation Trails;*
- h. Natural Areas;*
- i. Wilderness Areas;*
- j. Mineral and Aggregate Resources;*
- k. Energy sources;*
- l. Cultural areas.”*

The Greenbelt Land Trust owns or has conservation easements on four properties within the Corvallis MPO planning area. Those properties are Forest Dell (6 acres), Jackson-Frazier Wetlands (4 Acres), Owen’s Farm (95 acres), and Lupine Meadows (58 Acres). Additional properties in close proximity to the Planning Area include the Bald Hill Natural Area Addition (41 Acres), Fitton Green (140 acres) and Evergreen (223 acres).

L. Natural Hazard Areas

Benton County developed a Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan in 2006, which was updated in 2010 in conjunction with Marion and Linn Counties' plan update processes. This FEMA-approved plan is intended to assist Benton County and the cities of Adair Village, Albany, Corvallis, Monroe and Philomath in reducing risk from natural hazards and to help guide and coordinate mitigation activities throughout the county. The plan addresses the following hazards: Earthquakes, Floods, Landslides, Winter Storms, Wind Storms, Wildfires, Droughts and Volcanoes.

Additionally, the City of Corvallis developed Natural Hazards and Natural Resources Overlays as part of the implementation of Phase III of the 2006 Land Development Code (LDC). These overlays designate areas that are prone to a natural disaster such as flooding, earthquake, landslide, or fire. Areas that lie at or below river/creek level are susceptible to flooding, while areas on graded slopes may be susceptible to landslides.

N. Protected Riparian Corridors

Protected riparian corridors were identified within the Corvallis Urban Growth Boundary to meet State requirements under Oregon Administrative Rule 660-015-0000(5a).

Protected riparian corridors are an integral part of the stability of the ecology surrounding a waterway. A Riparian zone or corridor may include tree canopies, grassland, wild shrubs, woodland, and sometimes natural rocky embankments essential to the stability of the soils around the waterway. Riparian zones or corridors may be natural or engineered for soil

stabilization or restoration. These zones are important natural biofilters, protecting aquatic environments from excessive sedimentation, polluted surface runoff and erosion. They supply shelter and food for many aquatic animals and shade that is an important part of stream temperature regulation. When riparian zones are damaged by construction, agriculture or silviculture, biological restoration can take place, usually by human intervention in erosion control and revegetation.

Q. Stormwater Basins and Drainage

Stormwater runoff from land and impervious areas such as paved streets, parking lots, and building rooftops during rainfall and snow events often contain pollutants that could adversely affect water quality. Having a separate stormwater drainage system alleviates some of the residual affects of stormwater runoff.

National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits are required for storm water discharges to surface waters from construction and industrial activities and municipalities if stormwater from rain or snow melt leaves your site through a "point source" and reaches surface waters either directly or through storm drainage. A point source is a natural or human-made conveyance of water through such things as pipes, culverts, ditches, catch basins, or any other type of channel.

Municipal sources required to obtain NPDES Permit are classified as either "Phase I" or "Phase II" municipal separate storm sewer systems (MS4s). Phase I MS4s are those with populations greater than 100,000, while regulated Phase II (or "small") MS4s are those municipalities with populations less than 100,000 located within Census Bureau-defined Urbanized Areas. Federal regulations also provide EPA and the states the discretion to require other MS4s outside of Urbanized Areas to apply for a permit. Benton County and the cities of Philomath and Corvallis are required to obtain a Phase II Municipal Stormwater Permit from DEQ, requiring a stormwater system independent from its sewer system.

There are stream 20 basins within the Corvallis UGB. Each Basin is named after the primary water feature which impacts the area. For example, the Mary's River Basin is defined by the Marys River that runs through it. The City of Philomath also has a separate stormwater drainage system independent from its sewer system. The City of Adair Village applied for and received a waiver for obtaining a MS4 Phase II permit and is currently exempt from EPA Stormwater requirements.

Note: Due to limited availability of GIS data for Benton County, Philomath and Adair Village, stormwater basis and drainage system mapping may not be complete for these jurisdictions.

P. Wetlands and Wetlands Mitigation Banks

The Code of Federal Regulations Title 23, Part 777.7 (23 CFR Part 777.7) requires mitigation of transportation impacts on wetlands and natural habitats. Specifically:

- (1) The importance of the impacted wetlands and natural habitats;
- (2) The extent of highway impacts on the wetlands and natural habitats, as determined through an appropriate, interdisciplinary, impact assessment; and
- (3) *Actions necessary to comply with the Clean Water Act, Section 404, the Endangered Species Act of 1973, and other relevant Federal statutes.*
 - (b) *Evaluation of the importance of the impacted wetlands and natural habitats shall consider:*
 - (1) *Wetland and natural habitat functional capacity;*
 - (2) *Relative importance of these functions to the total wetland or natural habitat resource of the area;*
 - (3) *Other factors such as uniqueness, esthetics, or cultural values; and*
 - (4) *Input from the appropriate resource management agencies through interagency coordination.*
 - (c) *A determination of the highway impact should focus on both the short-and long-term effects of the project on wetland or natural habitat functional capacity, consistent with 40 CFR part 1500, 40 CFR 1502.16, 33 CFR 320.4, and the FHWA's environmental compliance regulations, found at 23 CFR part 771.*

A wetland can be thought of as the integration of terrestrial and aquatic areas, for which both are interdependent yet separate from one another. A wetland is typically defined first and foremost by the natural water features which serve host to biodiversity. In the CAMPO Planning Area, two major wetlands dominate the area: The Jackson-Frazier Wetland and the Duwani Creek Wetland. Having a wetlands designation, these areas enjoy a higher level of environmental protection and conservation, as both are integral to the stability of the native vegetation and wildlife habitats.

A wetlands mitigation bank can be a wetland, stream, or other aquatic resource area that has been restored, established, enhanced, or (in certain circumstances) preserved for the purpose of providing compensation for unavoidable impacts to aquatic resources permitted under Section 404 or a similar state or local wetland regulation. A mitigation bank may be created when a government agency, corporation, nonprofit organization, or other entity undertakes these activities under a formal agreement with a regulatory agency.

In the Corvallis MPO planning area, there are two mitigation banks identified by the Oregon Department of State Lands and the United States Army Corps. Of Engineers. They are:

- **Bank Name** - Frazier Creek
Nearest City - Corvallis
Approval Status - Approved Spring 2003
Approximate Size - 26 acres
Maximum credits to be developed - 13 credits first phase
- **Bank Name** - Evergreen
Nearest City - Philomath
Approval Status - Approved December 2006
Approximate Size - 175 acres

A possible future mitigation bank may lie within the Newton Creek Wetlands conservation easement currently held by the Greenbelt Land Trust. The property is 58 acres in size. The Greenbelt Land Trust is currently working with the City of Philomath on mitigating this property for banking purposes.

Additionally, the Oregon Cascades West Council of Governments is researching wetland mitigation banking strategies for industrial lands in the Central Willamette Valley. Based on an Economic Opportunities Analysis which projected the demand for industrial sites in eight cities through 2030, it was determined that that 100 to 300 acres of wetlands mitigation area would be required to meet demand for new industrial sites of ten or more acres, with additional mitigation areas required to meet industrial demand for sites of under ten acres.

Q. Willamette River Greenway

The Willamette River Greenway was originally established by the 1967 Oregon Legislature as a grant program to State Parks for land acquisition along the Willamette River. The Greenway evolved from a state parks and recreation program in 1970 to a corridor program in 1972. In 1973 it developed into a land use program under the joint administration by State Parks & Recreation Division, Land Conservation and Development Department and local jurisdictions. The protection of the Willamette River Greenway is Goal 15 in the Benton County Comprehensive Plan as well as Goal 15 in the Statewide Planning Goals. Protection of the

greenway is also discussed under Article 6 of the Corvallis Comprehensive Plan. The Greenway designation restricts or prevents certain land use activities from taking place along the Willamette River for the purpose of protecting the integrity of the river and its riparian zone.

R. Environmental Justice

Executive Order 12898, *Federal Actions to Address Environmental Justice in Minority Populations and Low-income Populations (1994)* was enacted to reinforce Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. In the Civil Rights Act it is stated that “No person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance” (*U.S. Code 1964*). Executive Order 12898 states, “Each Federal agency shall make achieving environmental justice part of its mission by identifying and addressing, as appropriate, disproportionately high and adverse human health or environmental effects of its programs, policies, and activities on minority populations and low-income populations” (*Federal Register 1994*).

As an entity utilizing federal funds, the Corvallis Area Metropolitan Planning Organization is responsible to successfully integrate environmental justice standards into its transportation program and planning activities. Any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance cannot discriminate against people based on race, color, national origin, age, sex, disability, religion or income status. Title VI and environmental justice laws require recipients of federal funds to:

1. Avoid, minimize, or mitigate disproportionately high and adverse effects of its activities on minority populations and low-income populations,
2. Ensure involvement of low-income and minority groups in the decision making process, and
3. Ensure low income and minority groups receive their fair share of benefits.

Using data from the 2010 U.S. Census, CAMPO produced maps illustrating the percent of minorities and percent of individuals below the federal poverty level in the Planning Area. The maps depict the data at the Census Tract level and will help identify populations within the Planning Area which are subject to the requirements of Title VI and environmental justice laws.

S. Consultation

CETAS is made up of representative of the following environmental and transportation related agencies:

- Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ);

- State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO);
- Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT);
- US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE);

The goal of the CETAS is to identify and implement collaborative opportunities to help each participating agency realize its mission through sound environmental stewardship, while providing for a safe and efficient transportation system.

Indian Tribes

There is no Indian reservation within or adjacent to the CAMPO Area. There are, however, two federally recognized Indian tribes within 50 miles radius of the MPO boundaries. These are the Confederated Indian Tribes of Siletz Indians located in Lincoln County (50 miles to the west) and the Confederated Indian Tribes of Grand Ronde located in Polk County (40 miles to the north).
